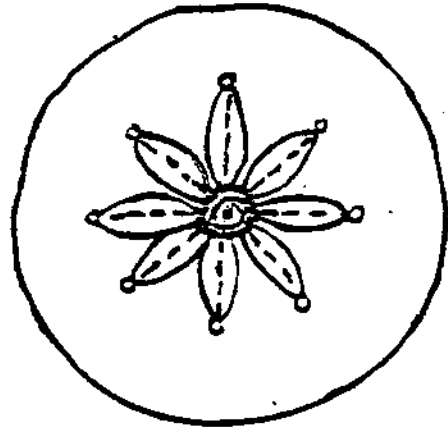

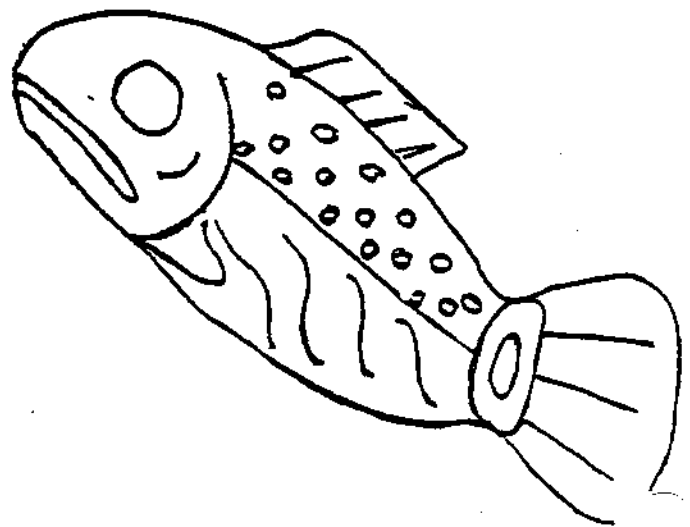

PATTERNS.

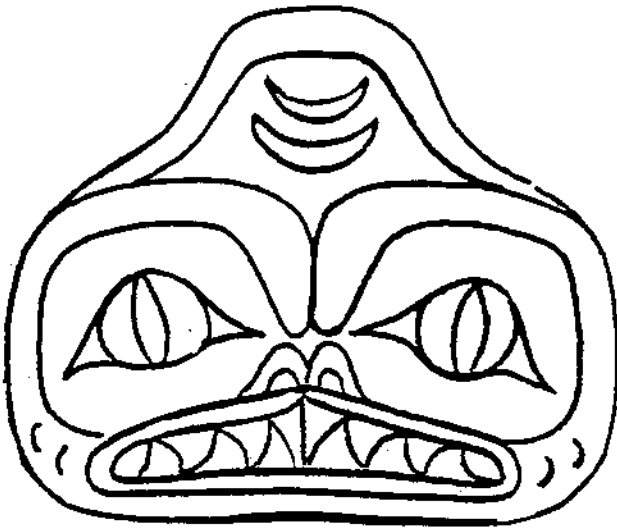
