Dear Fred :

I have been very busy so have not been able to write to you before. I will not have the time to write get any of the things you want for you here at Nome. But you may get some hard wood, leather, webbing and snaps at Kotzebue. I will allow you to spend \$20.00 for these things. No more. Get them at Kotzebue as it will not cost so much. Get one of the teachers at Kotzebue to make out a proper voucher and send voucher to me for payment. Better show one of the teachers this letter so that they will understand.

The Fair next year will be at Noatak. I hope some of the Noorvik men can come to Igloo also.

I leave on the BEAR tomorrow and wish I could see you.
