Tom Roust has loaned us a boiler with which to thaw the gravel.

and the R. M. Co. have furnished us 2 tons of coal and lumber and any further expenses which we can pay with remainder this fall.

The people are delighted with our plans for the spring move and I don't think many will wish to remain behind. They are working with a will and I don't see how I can begin school until the Cold Storage is complete.
