Dear Sir :

Mr. Replogle has requested that if possible Mr. Chas. Wentworth be employed by the Bureau to assist him in the erection of the new buildings at the new village on the Kobuk next spring. I do not know what we would have to pay him by the day nor just at what time Mr. Replogle would want him. These questions can be answered later.

Nor is it necessary for me to say much to endorse Mr. Wentworth, as I am sure he is known to you personally. He erected the Deering building. There is no one whom I would rather see engaged in this work, both on a count of his practical ability, and his excellent standing with the natives here.

I send this letter to prepare you for a telegram I may send on this matter later on in the season.
