I have just received a wire from Mr. Sinclair, Seattle, stating that the Kobuk reservation has been made. So the report published in the paper some time ago was authentic.

You can inform the natives that the Government at Washington has now recognized their desire to build a new village and to develop along their own lines, in their own place. So now they must take the responsibility upon themselves of doing all that they said they would do and of showing the President and the Government that they are worthy of all the trouble it has been to get this ground set apart for them.
