Finishing loading Deering all through Keewalik.
 No paper left at Deering made extra trip ~~to~~ Blossom.
 Got bills lading vouchers and manifest. Must leave
 Kavalina freight for Duxbry and Shismariff coal.
 One hundred seven sacks coal left at Blossom five
 hundred feet lumber. Freight scattered ten miles
 along beach from Cape Blossom to mission. Cannot
 gather all up. Shismariff coal and some merchandise
 at Deering. No vouchers left for Shismariff. Will leave
 Kavalina vouchers with school teacher Deering. Kavalina
 teacher at Blossom. Valanti not in sight. Left twenty
 boxes sugar on Seson lighter, Nome, spoiled. Bender
 Brothers will not be responsible for shortage of
 freight. Notify my owner Mr. Rank freight consigned
 to Mr. Lopp for native is prepaid by Valanti from
 Seattle to Blossom. They want me to collect advance
 charges. Advise what to do. Arrange for missionary
 freight from Deering to Point Hope. Arrange to collect
 freight. Missionary in Nome. Waiting for answer.
