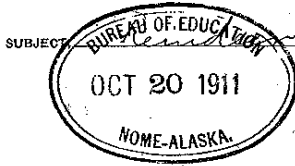

Dear Sir;

Stanley tells of 3 deer belonging to him, which were in the Mission Herd when it was left here in 1905. He says Keok killed them for the Mission. I do not understand whether these 3 were part of the 100 which the Mission rec'd in 1905, and whether the Mission returned 100 to the Govt at the end of 5 years or how it is. He thought you would know. Mrs. R. M. Hare who has charge of the Mission herd would follow instructions from you regarding this, I presume, and report the same to the Missionary Board.

I have been getting statistics from Stanley, but have not the reports from June 30, 1910 to June 30, 1911 completed yet. He expects to take his herd
