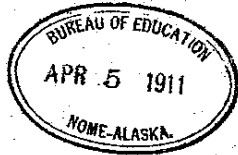

Dear Mr. Shields-

Enclosed find voucher for telephoning to Candle. Last June a native fell from the cliff and I did all I knew but he was desperately hurt & so felt need of aid & phoned to learn if there was anything further that could be done. There was no help however & he died that night of internal hemorrhage.

In Dec. I had a very sick woman. Her temperature to  $105\frac{1}{2}$  & then I telephoned. The Dr. wanted me to phone again as he thought it might be a case needing an operation - so the two messages. The woman recovered but it took hard work to save her. Dr. Newson was absent on medical trips at those times. He has gone now on trip to Kotzebue, Kivalina, Noatak, & Selkirk way stations.

I hope this voucher is correct, having only made a couple to of these "other than personal". I do not remember exactly about the places of signing.
