

Mr. Walter Shields,

Dear Sir -

The letter authorizing us to spend \$5 for repair of chimney was not recd in Deering until July 8th - the first boat so it would have been impossible to have used it on before June 30th.

The natives here have caught few salmon - the water being too high in the river for their traps to be used to advantage, & few have seines. We have sent several families up the river to get salmon for their dogs. I am afraid that they will be in much want during the winter. Then too we have eleven widows here, some, of whom have little or no means of support. I feel that we will need much more than last year under the head of destitution.

We have had no news as yet of an assistant. I do hope that one will be available as we fell to needs of one.
