My dear Mrs. Newsom;-

Referring to your communication of April 21 concerning a bill for oil purchased from Robinson, Magids Co. , I wish to say that at their request the voucher for \$22.50 was made payable to Mr. Greenberg who was then in Nome and that our records show that a check for that amount was handed to Mr. Greenberg Feb. 18th.

The voucher referred to as due from 1908 was questioned when I was at Deering and I later took it up with the Candler office. They claimed that they had not received payment, though they acknowledge receiving payment of an account rendered a few weeks earlier than the mentioned. Upon taking the matter up with the Washington office, last summer they reported it paid. Upon the company insisting that they had not received payment, I wrote requesting the Treasury Department to inform me to whom the check was issued; if it had been cashed. I have not as yet received a reply. As soon as I hear I shall be pleased to notify them.

Will you please show this letter to Mr. Greenberg.
