

The Five dollars, for board & lodging was
on a check book I left at DeLarue last spring (by mistake)
the fares to Kotzebue return I know, was not for myself
alone but we were informed at DeLarue we would be expected
to go to Kotzebue in the summer & with the other teachers the
fares for all were paid from DeLarue, so we feel it only what
others have received so I put in the account as you have it
I trust I have done nothing amiss.

I am surprised the Bureau have cut on my transportation
expenses & will do the best I can, nevertheless.

I have received no instructions regarding my next years work
if none are received I will go on making as many trips as possible
call on all the people & render every aid I can. (I refer to blanks I filled
out last year.)

You spoke in your letter on last mail of experiences we have had
during the last year; I suppose you as well as we never had seen such
cold weather, we traveled the very coldest day of the winter but we will not
next winter I hope, we did not freeze but we don't want to, I do not
dread the severe cold so much, the snow wind storms, drifting snow & dark
days make life most miserable, kind regards from all of us very respectfully yours
