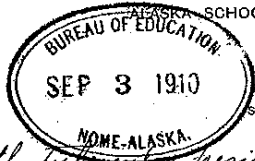

*June 9<sup>th</sup>*, 1910SUBJECT, *Report for May, 1910.*

- May 1. Patient with tubercular peritonitis. gave Bell & enema.
- May 2. confinement case. successful delivery. called on consumptive.
- May 3. called to see new baby. all well; gave enema again also enema to consumptive; made brace for tubercular spine.
- May 4. called again to see tubercular spine. patient called with bowel trouble gave laxative. examined three other natives; all well.
- May 5. gave enema again; gave Malted milk. patient seemed better.
- May 6. called to see consumptive. using yellow iodide of mercury & bronchitis tablet.
- May 7. gave enema again.
- May 8. consumptive died; hemorrhage of the lungs.
- May 9. called to see tubercular throat; also a case of sore throat. (simple)
- May 10. called to see case tubercular glands. (cervical) also has lung trouble developing. advised extreme care & rich diet, outdoor life. gave iodide of mercury & bronchitis tablets.
- May 11. called to see tubercular throat.
- May 13. called to see Neuralgia (intercostal). chronic throat trouble chronic gastritis gave for neuralgia. Neuralgia tablet. (asom, Bell. cold. ointment) for gastritis gave Bell & advised light diet. throat trouble Bell.
- May 26. case cystitis gave gelsam.
- May 28. saw cystitis case again.
- May 22 & 23. treated case articular rheumatism. (Massage)
