Dear Sir :

I have been instructed by Supt. Evans ^(P 88) not to pay any expense vouchers for board of Bureau employes while travelling and stopping in Government buildings that exceed two dollars per day. As the Government buildings are for the use of Bureau employes, teachers can not charge for lodging, but they can for board at the rate of two dollars per day.

I therefore return herewith the following vouchers, which you should rewrite, approve and have them signed by the parties furnishing the board.

(216) L. C. Sickles, Selawik, board and lodging Dec. 16 to 20, \$14.00
 (293) W. H. Cox, 12 days board and room, 36.00

These vouchers should be for board only, and should not exceed \$2.00 per day.

In connection with all of your vouchers I would suggest that you give each one a general heading before listing the items, as follows :

To board furnished Dr. E. W. Newson (give title) while travelling on official business: (then list the days).

I have to handle a great many vouchers covering different accounts and such headings, while required by the rules also held me greatly in quickly determining to which account the voucher is to be charged.
