We all stood up and thanked Mrs Ahnemaynuk and Mrs Kooteck for they clean Mrs Tulacocksick's house whomk her little boy died. We talk about club rules and Mrs Kagoone want us to all try to be pure in our lives and to help all the other women to be pure to. We all stand up to tell that we want that for a club rule. We promise to try to be bettwives and better mothers. We promise to wash our bodies and our hair and our clothes and to wash the bodies and hair and clothes of all our family: We promise to chase lies and not to let them stop on our bodies, on our heads or in our houses. We promise to have clean houses and to try to keep them tidy. We will try to have boxed, shelves, hooks and supboards in our houses so our things will not be left upon the floor. Another olub rule is to wash our dishes everying time anyone use them and to have each person use their own dishes and not eat from same seal gil dish. Another rule is that we will try to wash our hands before we touch food. And everyone stand up to toll that they want these for our club rules.

After that Mrs Michols said to us to go out in the fresh air . School house is not good to stay in too long.
