My dear Doctor Nichols:

Your letter of the 14th. was received a few days ago. I also received a letter from Mr. Sickler regarding the amount of sickness at Shungnak. Knowing Mr. Sickler the way I do, I do not believe he would have asked for advice or assistance along medical lines if he had not been badly in need of it. I really hope that you have decided to go and have gone. I think I can allow you at least \$50.00 additional for this trip. As I say, I hope you have gone.

I will be at the Fair at Igloo until about Jan. 15 and will go direct from there to Deering and then to Kotzebue. I should be at Kotzebue somewhere near the end of January. Then I will go to Neatak and Kivalina. This year I will reverse my trip entirely. I expect to bring a native with me from here. I enclose a letter regarding the pair. I hope to have one in Kotzebue Sound next year.
