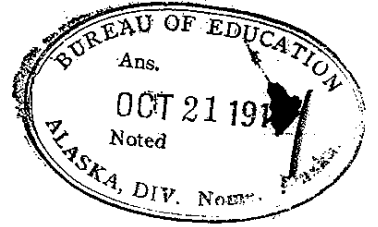

Dear Mr. Shields:-

The enclosed bids were made & accepted before the arrival of Mr. & Mrs. Ausley in Hotyebue. They arrived the morning the freight was to have left, accordingly I asked to have the man carrying the freight wait till they could get their supplies off the *Bordova* so that one trip would do. It cost Mr. Ausley \$80.00 to get his private supplies taken from Hotyebue to Noatak.
