Kotzebue July 1, 1914

SUBJECT, Annual Report

Sir:

I had a position as assistant teacher and was assigned to Kotzebue. I was very sorry not to begin from the first of the Service. I did not get my appointment until the last part of December, it was so delayed coming. As soon as I received my appointment my husband, myself and baby started immediately for Kotzebue. We left Deering December 30, and reached Kotzebue the 1st of January.

After I got to Kotzebue, Miss Hwak did not need an assistant with her school work so she thought of some thing for me to work on, in the fore noon. I also came in after noons and helped the small girls with sewing. I did some drawing, also copied the inventory and counted the books.

Since Superintendent Shields had been here I have been helping Doctor Nichols most of the time copying for him his permanent record cards and making out the village inspection sheets. I also did some interpreting for him.
