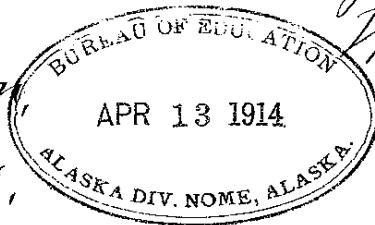

Dear Mr. Johnson:-

At your earliest convenience, Mr. Johnson, could you get some alcohol for me at the drug store? I am nearly out. Perhaps you have already sent some which is still on the way. None, however, came on the last mail which reached Kotzebue about Mch. 12. I need one gallon at once for making chloroform liniment. I need it for numerous other purposes (not internal). I would like two gallons by parcel post. Have the druggist thoroughly wrap & protect it from breakage in the mail. Have him put it up in 1 quart, 2 qt. & 1 gallon, or 2 gal. containers, tin or glass as he thinks best. Pay for it out of my subauthorization, M 45-2, & let me know the cost.

Two gallons, please, Mr. Johnson, I am sorry to trouble you, ~~Mr. Johnson~~ but can't very well help it.
