like two ^{gals} gallons, one will do for a little while.

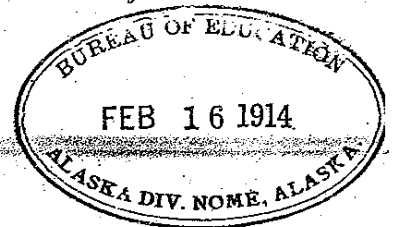
(c) Chloroform Lincture, one gallon. No I will

(c) Tincture of Iodine. Concentrated if it can be
secured, otherwise the U. S. P. tincture. A gallon
would last for a long time depending on run of
cases I have. Call it $\frac{1}{2}$ gallon. 1 qt

(d) \$3.00 family sized jar of Horlick's malted
milk (It is a powder & don't freeze).
