Dear Miss Cora B.:-

I'm sorry that Friday had to come and spoil a nice vacation (Jan 2.) but it will be alright as soon as I get a card to the effect that the ONE day lost will be made up on a holiday or Sat. We took it here and Miss Anderson will make it up on a Holiday and say nothing about it on her card.

I wonder what success you are having with the oil-burner? They work very good in Nome. The only trouble is to get them arranged so that they wont make a lot of racket.
