Dear Friend Nichols:-

Enclosed are a few checks for your pleasure. At least I find it a pleasure to hand out some body else's money. I trust that it will not inconvenience you to see that the enclosed checks reach the proper people. They are charged to the following accounts.

Kotzebue E 43-5	\$5.50
" N 46-4	19.50
" M 45-2	54.00.

I had to charge \$3.00 to Miss Hawks E 43-5 on account of Herold Brown and John Beaver transferring supplies from beach to school. The rest of their account was charged to your medical.

By the way Nichols, - whenever an authorization is charged against Miss Hawks E 43-5 she and no one else should sign on the second place for certification. I notice that you have been signing on her account vouchers. Of course I have said nothing but have gone ahead and paid. She has not mentioned it and so probably does not know that she alone is responsible for all charges against her E 43-5 Just suggest sort of casually, that she certify to expenditures against that account. Try to hold expenditures that are small and when you get about \$10.00 dollars worth put them all on one voucher and then mail to me. This last trip you had two vouchers that were for 50¢ each. Twelve vouchers that aggregated less than forty dollars. By using extra sheets and sub-vouchers you could have placed everything on three or four. Try it next time.

I will try to keep you posted as to your balances and etc.
