Dear Sir:

Enclosed you will find voucher other than personal for \$7.75 with the three subvouchers attached one for \$2.00 eight toxes B.B.Cubes for hospital use. \$2.75 groceries used on return trip from Kivalina. While with Mr. Shields he furnished all the Kow Kow etc. The one for \$3.00 was for one third cord of dry wood for hospital. When Mr. Shields returns think he will increase my authorization that I may purchase cord or two more wood and in case I have to make any more trips after I return from Shungnak will have about \$70.00 to start on the Shungnak trip with if I don get called anywhere before I go there. Will not go over my allowance anyway, that is I wont issue vouchers, in case I have to make trips and get short. In that case will spend it out of my own pocket and wait for an authorization from Shields.

Am sending voucher for \$20.00 four days dogteam hire Kotzebus to Noatak (east channel) and return. about 40 miles from here. It took us two days each way on account of heavy trail (about six inches soft snow) For the groceries during the trip I issued voucher direct to Tom Berryman for \$6.40 Was called to Noatak on account of

Auguwik (native woman) being sick.

Gallahorn (native) is for hospital use. Have had patients confined to hospital continuously for past two months, and two of them will be there for six or eight weeks more. Will now have enough wood with the coal to last me until Shields returns, then if it is necessary he will allow me more for hospital expenses etc. They have to haul their wood about 18 miles from the Noatak and at times it is impossible to buy wood at all. I intend to explain everything in my letters to you so Mr. Shields can go over them if he wishes and get any information regarding conditions here. When he returns from the north I will nodoubt be up at Shungnak.
