Enclosed herewith please find a copy of the description of a tract of land claimed by the Friends' Mission Society by for their mission at Kotzebue, Alaska. The tract of land staked by the missionary, April, 1908, was in conflict with the tract staked for the Bureau of Education and consisting of forty acres, which amount was allowed by Executive order dated May 4, 1907. Mr. W.H. Cox, present Missionary in charge informs me that the present tract, staked Sept. 26, 1910 does not conflict with the ^{tract} claimed by the Bureau of Education, a description of which was sent to you by Assistant Superintendent Hawksworth.
