Dear Sir;

Acting on your suggestion, we hold school in two sections now, the younger ones from 9 till 12:30 and the older ones from 12:30 till 4:10 P.M. making 7 hrs. 10 min. each day. And besides this the older ones have Industrial work in the kitchen 2 days each week beginning at 9 A.M. and lasting most of the day, when they bake bread and wash, the boys one day and the girls one day. I think more is being accomplished and with much less confusion than by the former arrangement. We have 40 in school now. I help plan the work for my assistant and her helper each day.

I am perplexed as to how to make out the Report Cards under this changed arrangement.

Count both younger and older ones present 2 half days each day? And how many hours each day shall we say we have taught?
