Dear Sir :

The following special items Mr. Replegle wishes added to the requisition for NOORVIK.

30 gal. Outside white paint,
10 " White enamel for inside.
3 lbs. Prussian blue .
3 " Drop black
2 gal. Banana oil (this is a new one on W.S.)

Mr. Replegle adds the following:

"The supplies for the new school will have to reach Kotzebue earlier than the Cordova usually gets here as the river will freeze up about the 23 or thereabouts and we will have no time to transport the material to Noorvik. The Cordova does not unload at Kotzebue until about the 20th of September and that is too late for us. "
