Dear Sir:

I closed school at Kivalina March 31, and started for Pt. Hope, Monday April 3. Stayed one night near Cape Thompson and another at the reindeer camp here and reached the school house the night of April 6. I found things here much as I expected.

The people were anxious for school to begin at once. By hard work we were able to get the house partially cleaned and things in shape to start school April 13.

Fearing that the coal here would be insufficient and that it would be impossible to get fuel later on I procured four sled loads of wood on my own responsibility. I think it will be sufficient for the remainder of the term.
