with the exception of one are in one family. Dr. Hotchkiss has taken the necessary presentionary measures but there is a chance
that it will spread and will cause an epidemic. In that case
it is desirable that a physician be on the ground. I have handed this letter to Mr. Allen with instructions to forward it to you
in case others are attacked, and hope you will be able to come up
and take cahrge of the situation. If you come up I would advise that
you bring necessary supplies with you and you can then occupy the
school house and render the necessary assistance.
