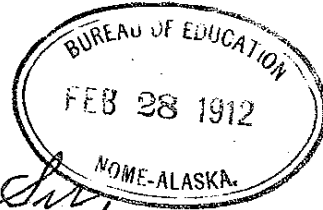

I have held back most of the clothes and other wares in order that you might have something with which to equip new apprentices if you wished to put on any this year.
