Mr. Evans:

The enclosed allotment allows you only \$240 for Chief Herders and \$700 for moving herds. You can use deer as payment of Chief Herders in ~~some~~ <sup>most</sup> places, <sup>where they go</sup> and think in the case of Pt Hope and Selawik you can allow Chief Herders liberal pay for moving herd. It seems unfortunate we haven't about twice as much for Chief herders.

If I can change this so as to allow you more, I will do so. If you have any changes to suggest, wire me.

I shall notify you of any changes I make in this allotment.

We ran in close to Mt Killag this P.M. Building looks fine. Part of the shingles are on. I put Missions mail of at Andraefski. — I think I shall be able to return to St Michaels about Oct 5<sup>th</sup> and hope to reach Unalakleet a few days later. Yours
