Sirs;

Captain Backlund of the Transit landed all of the Pt. Hope Pt. Hope supplies at the Mission on the north side of the Point about eight miles from the Government School. Mr. Sickler had no funds for moving the supplies to the school and Captain Backlund had declined to pay for moving the supplies on the ground that he had delivered the supplies at Pt. Hope.

I instructed Mr. Sickler to have natives move the supplies to the school in native boats at as reasonable a price as possible and send me a statement of the expense which will be forwarded to you. I recommend that the amount be deducted from Capt. Backlund's freight money.
