inform and instruct them. Ask me what
months and salary for Ivanoff and to make
recommendations regarding Ellayok. Have wired
my getting \$60 per Oct-June, inclusive and \$200
travelling expenses -

The "North Bend" has carried the Unalakleet
shingles on north (22 ton) I have purchased
them here for \$2 per ton and shipped them to Unalak-
leet. If you see White, or can get word to him
better tell him to leave them at Walea or Gambell -

referred the matter to Brown suggesting that Updegraff

Kobbe said emphatically that they would
have no native children.
