Well I have come good news for you. you remember I had quite a time getting Wick Hall to pay the Stootak natives for freighting last Summer.) When we Came from Noatak in april some of the natives who were extitle to payment for the freighting last Summer, Came with us and I went-with them to Dick Hall and asked him to pay those who were freel, and he paid them in money who did not want trale, except-fames Me, Chillan who was not present, and Dick promised to pay him this Summer when the Noatak natives come from Seeling Fourt With best wishes to your self and family, Dam, Checuce aus
