In our first mail - about a week ago - we received the circular letter sentout by The Sopp regarding the valuation of native property in our village. It is absolutely impossible for us to gather this information at the present time as most of our people have left toopy

they are just completing a good cabin for her.
The reinden boys brought the herd from
Sealing Point on Nov. 8 and Mr. Ausley Went

for two days, and made another trips on Nov. 27th.
He thought best, likewise the boys, to move the
herd to a better grazing place 4 miles south
west of the old location. They have their
Cabin almost completed now and will be
more comfortably located in every respect.
