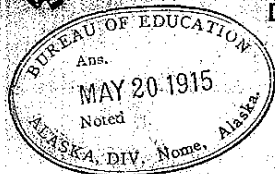

SUBJECT

Mr. Walter C. Shields,

Nome, Alaska

Dear Sir,

We arrived at Kivalina safely on the morning of April 6, about two o'clock. Paul and Ignarius brought us over. Since we came we have been helping with school, village, medical and church work. All your people are at Sealing Point, some of them come up every few days. We will go down very soon, as there will soon be plenty of wood on the beach. All your natives are well and are anxious for us to come down.

Paul wrote us the deer were doing well and there were many fawns. He wants to know how many deer you will allow him June 30th. He did not receive any food from the Government this year. The two sled deer which were lost and some of the other stray deer have been found.
