Dear Sir :

You are hereby authorized to furnish Niglik, an Eskimo reindeer herder from Noatak, with the supplies he may ask for up to the amount of Seventy five Dollars, (\$75.00). These supplies are to be furnished by your Kotzebue store, and you are to accept the voucher that will be presented by Niglik, and use it to submit your bill for the said supplies to the Nome office, where payment will be made. The voucher has been made out and all that will be necessary for you to do will be to enter thereon the supplies furnished and their price and sign the voucher.

In making this arrangement I have been influenced by the fact that you have informed Mr. Shields that you will furnish flour at \$4.00 per hundred and sugar at \$8.00 per hundred.
