If I remember correctly, the voucher was presented by Fred Sickler, teacher at Shungnak, in reimbursement for money paid the natives for carrying part of this freight part of the way to Shungnak.

I advised you while here that all of the freight charges covering the delivery of the Shungnak freight from Kotzebue to Shungnak, would be paid out of my authorization and you took back to Nome with you this voucher of Fred Sickler's and were to write him that all these charges would be paid by Capt. Backland. Will you kindly send to me Fred Sickler's Voucher and I will try to collect the amount from Capt. Backland and return to Mr. Sickler. Kindly let me have this voucher as early as possible as Capt. Backland may be in at any time.
