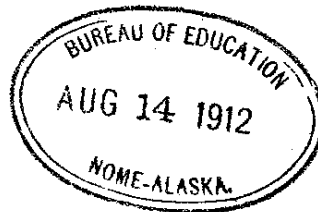

Dear Sir:

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter, dated May 30th, 1912. I wish to say in reply the report you referred to on building materials is not complete owing to the fact that there was no inventory of these things on file at the Station. I cannot make the detailed report you ask for until I return to Shungnak. I am under the impression, however, that most of the things mentioned in the two bills are still on hand but I know that some of the lumber and nails have been used in repairing the school property. There are seven rolls of building paper, two doors and several boxes of nails in the storeroom. The T Blue Tile referred to, I think, is being used in the schoolhouse to connect the pipes from the kitchen and living room.
