as I would like if he could telegraph
to Washington and secure this School
for an Episcopal School Teacher, and I beg
of you to help the good cause along

I have met Mr Stuk and he knows me
so I wrote him all about things here.
I am the Deputy recorder & assistant Post
master here. & a few days ago last
Monday there was a community of ten
of the leading Eskimoes appeared in my
office and ask for assistance in their troubles
and their greivances. They finally concluded
their meeting with complaints to the U. S.
Board of Education at Washington D. C. for
the removal of their teachers here also a
petition to the Friends Church at California
for the removal of them as missionaries but
asking the Friends Church for another mission-
ary as they will try one more if they
have a good one to send them. at present
the Eskimoes wont attend the services
here and I dont blame them they are
not treated right there is much I would
like to write you. But ask one more for
gods sake rein the appointment of this school
for a Episcopal school teachers & the result will be the
