Dear Sir :

Mr. Allan has presented your voucher for June salary which you have assigned to him. It is one of the rules of the service that the June salaries cannot be paid until all of the reports have been received, especially the reindeer reports. In your case no reindeer reports have been received from you for the Shungnak herd. A supply of blanks was sent you and I cannot understand why the reports have not reached here. I hope they will come on the next boat.

In this case I have paid Mr. Allan your salary for that month, but will have to suspend payment on the July voucher until the Shungnak reports are received. If these reports have never been made out I would suggest that you communicate at once with the Shungnak teacher.

This rule is one of the rules laid down by the Commissioner, and I am making payment only because the voucher has been assigned and I am willing to take that responsibility. Please assist me in this matter by getting the Shungnak report here as soon as possible.
