My Dear Mr Eames. We arrived here the first of July found every body well.

We have applied to Mr M. F. Moran in regard the marriage of Ace Wilson living with a native woman. He tells us that he will not do any thing until he gets written authority ^{from} the officials at Some. I think it would be well to have them write him regarding the matter.

Have any white men any right to build any cabins ^{on} the street on ^{the} U.S. Reserve. We have been informed by persons that claim to know the law that any one has a right to build on the water front, we would like to know about it as we do not want to

to anything that is not right, and if they have a right to build on the water front I don't think it advisable to object to houses building anywhere on the Reserve for they would make more trouble on the river front than any where else, I would like to have some information along these lines as we are in a position that we have to take a firm stand and we do not want to do any thing that is not legal and just and be censured for being willful and ~~revengeful~~ for we are not we only want to do what is right and just.

We are patiently waiting for the arrival of the Corwin.

Mr. Dickler are not here yet I understand they are on their way. Mr. Harrenson are here.
