Referring to yours of Sept. 21, I have to state that the voucher for services rendered by Mr. Charles Howland, carrying freight from Kotzebue for Shungnak School, was made out for work done during the month of Sept. 1908. The launches were frozen in half way up the Kobu and a part of the freight sledged to destination. In taking up the matter for settlement with Mr. Howland on his return to Nome, in June. The proposals signed by Mr. Howland were forwarded to the Washington office, together with a statement of the circumstances connected with entire transaction.
