June 30/1908

I submit the following report
 Mr. Chilton, arrived here last Feb. 17
 from Unalakleet with 277 deer in
 good condition on the way three
 gave out and had to be killed lost
 one killed one for meat, have lost
 by sickness and crippled six since
 they have been here. We were out
 to see the boys twice at the herd
 and found every thing in good
 condition the deer doing fine along
 the pick river with all the range
 and moss they can handle for
 several years they surely have a
 fine place and also have a good
 head herder who understands
 handling the deer. We found there
 were 119 fawns born 101 living 50 males
 51 females a loss of 18. The apprentices
 boys which were chosen like their work
 very much.
