I have already settled with the natives, as Mr. Lopp, told me, I should sell enough goods that they were sending up here to pay for same, so I have done as he requested me to do at Loring, I am sorry that I did not get your letter until yesterday Lated Sept. ~~17th~~ for I would have been pleased to comply with your wishes. Mr. Chitkin goes to Unalakleet next week then we will be with at a head header. The ^(apprentice) boys are doing nicely. We have almost all our provisions here now. We are anxiously waiting to see you here. I think it very important for you to come this winter. Thank you for Ober slips at Seattle yours truly
