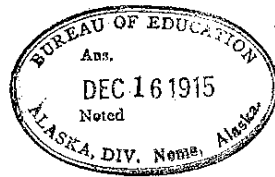

Dear Sir, I recieved your letter of recent date concerning the voucher of Lewis Lloyd. I sent this in September, I believe but Moran tells me that that mail was detained at Kotzebue, as it was too late for Navigation. You have no doubt recieved the voucher by this time.

The natives continue to have bad health and we have had two deaths recently. Old man Sun's family and several others who were camped near him, have been and are yet very sick with a fever.

The new missionary, Miss Stratton is very quiet, and is not giving us any trouble.

There are no ptarmigan and no rabbits near the school so I expect a small attendance this winter.
