
CHILKAT BLANKET BOX (Papier Mache)

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Cardboard box with lid
- Cardboard scraps
- Masking tape
- 4. Wheat paste
 5. Brown paper towels or old newspapers
 6. Large can or bucket for mixing

- Sponge
 Burnt Umber acrylic paint
 Black acrylic paint



STEP 4

- Draw, trace or copy the desired design onto the box.
- 2. Wet the sponge with water and apply a small amount of burnt umber all over the box.
- Let box dry.
- 4. Check design on box and redo any areas too hard to see.
- 5. Mix black paint slightly until the paint is smooth.
- 6. Paint the areas with the black paint until all areas are covered with a painted design.

The completed imitation Chilkat Blanker Box can be used in many ways in the classroom setting. The project can be used for motivation when introducing a lesson or unit or it can be used on an individual basis for storage of Indian related projects or simply as decorative object for the home.
