ACROSS

- 1. Shakes, or roof shingles for the summer houses were made of this wood
- 5. With 3 Down, a plant whose roots were soaked and cooked before being eaten
- 6. These plants grew along the stream where Kahtahah and Tsoonkla watched a bear fish
- 7. Snook's canoes had to travel for many miles over the _____ before arriving at fish camp
- 8. This type of salmon made up Kahtahah's first meal after she got to summer fish camp
- 10. This animal, which usually ran in a pack, had driven the deer away from Snook's summer camp
- 11. The wood from this plant was burned for smoking fish
- 14. Traps were placed in the outer bay for this shellfish

- 14. Tallow from these animals was used as hand lotion to keep Kahtahah's hands smooth
- 15. Boys fished for this kind of trout with fishing spears

DOWN

- 1. This hard little fruit was sometimes cooked in a pit oven
- 2. Same as 14 across
- 3. With 5 Across, a plant with a brown, bell-like flower
- 4. The large leaves of this plant were wrapped around meat when it was cooked in a pit oven
- 7. This plant from the sea was used in cooking in a pit oven
- 9. This covered the meadow and was burned off to encourage new growth
